## **Malcolm Clean-up Day**

Clean up day is scheduled for **April 12, 2025!!** The Village will be providing dumpsters in front of the Maintenance Building at 300 South Exeter Street from 8:00 a.m. till 4:30 p.m. on that **Saturday Only**. **Prohibited items include** paint, chemicals, antifreeze, insecticides, batteries, and oil. We will accept branches and brush, but **NO** grass clippings. **Please DO NOT place ANYTHING in the dumpsters before 8:00 a.m. on Saturday the 12<sup>th</sup>.**

- ***GOODWILL ITEMS*** – *The Goodwill truck will be onsite from 2:30 p.m.-4:30 p.m.*

## **Dog License Renewals**

Dog license renewals are due by June 1, 2025. Enclosed is a renewal application. If you own a dog, it must be licensed through the Village Office. A copy of the rabies vaccination certificate, showing the current vaccination date(s), must be submitted with the renewal application and will not be returned. However, if your dog is already licensed through the Village and has a current rabies vaccination on file, you do not need to submit another copy.

## **Chicken License Renewals**

As of December 7, 2022, the keeping of chickens is permitted within Village limits. To ensure compliance with local ordinances, all chicken owners are required to obtain a license through the Village Hall. Annual chicken license renewals are due by June 1, 2025. Enclosed is a renewal application for your convenience.

## **BUILDING PERMITS**

All residents living within the Village limits and/or within the one-mile jurisdiction of the Village of Malcolm are required to apply for a building permit through the Malcolm Village Office for ALL PROJECTS. Building permit forms as well as the Malcolm Municipal Code can be found on our website at [www.malcolm.ne.gov](http://www.malcolm.ne.gov). Chapter 9 informs you of which projects need a building permit, and which projects are exempt from a building permit. Chapter 12 informs you of the Zoning Regulations and setbacks required for your project(s).

## **GOLF CARTS**

Just a friendly reminder, Chapter 5, Article 3, Section 5-304 outlines the regulations regarding the operation of golf carts, ATVs, and other off-highway vehicles within the Village of Malcolm. This ordinance specifies where and when these vehicles may be operated, who is permitted to operate them, and the minimum age requirement for drivers on public streets. Please review the ordinance to ensure compliance with local regulations.

Village Board meetings as well as the Planning Commission meetings are opened to the public, your input is especially important to the continued growth and everyday concerns of the Village. **The Board cannot help with any problems that might arise within the Village unless you bring the problems or concerns to the Board.** The Village Board meetings are held on the first Wednesday of each month, beginning at 7:00 p.m. The Malcolm Planning Commission meetings are held on the last Wednesday of each month, beginning at 7:00 p.m.
