## **WINTER IS COMING!**

Please remove all vehicles, boats, campers, and trailers from the streets so the Village can properly plow and sand after snowstorms.

### **Snow Removal Policies:**

- Plowing begins after 3" of snow accumulation.
- Remove vehicles from the street to allow full plowing.
- Avoid parking directly across from other vehicles to ensure safe passage for snowplows and emergency vehicles.
- Sidewalks must be cleared within 5 hours after a storm (Code 8-203).
- If there's a fire hydrant nearby, please clear snow around it for quicker Fire Department access.
