WINTER IS COMING!

Please remove all vehicles, boats, campers, and trailers from the streets so the Village can properly plow and sand after snowstorms.

Snow Removal Policies:

- Plowing begins after 3" of snow accumulation.
- Remove vehicles from the street to allow full plowing.
- Avoid parking directly across from other vehicles to ensure safe passage for snowplows and emergency vehicles.
- Sidewalks must be cleared within 5 hours after a storm (Code 8-203).
- If there is a fire hydrant nearby, please clear snow around it for quicker Fire Department access.

PAY YOUR WATER AND SEWER BILL ONLINE AND PAPERLESS BILLING

For the convenience of our residents, the Village of Malcolm is pleased to offer several easy ways to manage and pay your water and sewer bill. In addition to traditional payment methods, you now have the option to pay online and auto pay. Receive billing notifications through email and text message.

We also encourage you to take advantage of **paperless billing**. This option allows you to receive your monthly bill electronically rather than through mail, reducing paper waste and giving you faster, more reliable access to your account information. With paperless billing, you will no longer need to wait for a bill to arrive in your mailbox, you will be able to view your statement as soon as it is available, right from your email or text message. It is a simple, environmentally friendly, and secure way to stay on top of your account.

Signing up for paperless billing and auto pay or making a payment is quick and easy. Visit www.malcolm.ne.gov/payment-options, then click the button on the right-hand side or at the bottom of the page. You will be directed to a secure landing page where you can follow the prompts to complete your enrollment. Please have your account number ready when you sign up.

BUILDING PERMITS

All residents living within the Village limits and/or within the one-mile jurisdiction of the Village of Malcolm are required to apply for a building permit through the Malcolm Village Office for ALL PROJECTS. Building permit forms as well as the Malcolm Municipal Code can be found on our website at www.malcolm.ne.gov. Chapter 9 informs you of which projects need a building permit, and which projects are exempt from a building permit. Chapter 12 informs you of the Zoning Regulations and setbacks required for your project(s).
